#### **II. Communications from the Public**

##### **James Rush, AYSO**

"I am in support of increasing the field rates to \$7.00 per hour for fiscal year 2025 and then increasing the rates to \$10.00 per hour for fiscal year 2026. As a AdHoc committee all of us agreed that the cost recovery percentage for "everyone plays" leagues shall be between 20 -30%. In order to ensure compliance with that threshold we must increase the rates suggested above.

Through this process we got a lot done, we were able to share and address our concerns, and the city heard the concerns of the leagues and their constituents. I appreciate the partnership and hope to see the committee continue so we can grow the partnerships between the City and leagues."

### **III. Field Use Rates: Formulating and Finalizing Recommendations (Continued)**

Councilmember, Tony Daddario, opens the conversation with the proposed rate of \$7.00 in 2025, increasing to \$10.00 in 2026. All were in agreement with the new proposed rate increase. Ms. Donna Finch suggests that the master plan fee schedule will need to be amended to reflect this increase.
