## The Ask...

That the City Council discuss the Corona Municipal Code proposed updates and authorization changes related to purchasing



#### Recap From May 21, 2025 Meeting

- √ Staff went over desired changes to purchasing section of Municipal Code
  - ✓ Ranging from language cleanup to updating authority levels
- ✓ Council asked for changes:
  - ✓ Section 3.08.040 (B) Basis of awards
  - ✓ Section 3.08.040 (L) Delegation of department director authority
- ✓ Council asked to see City Manager Authority levels of other cities for professional services/non-public projects

#### **Updated Municipal Code Changes**



- ✓ Section 3.08.040 (B) Basis of awards
  - Updated language to show "lowest responsive and responsible bidder"
  - Added sentence that refers to other "relevant factors"
- ✓ Section 3.08.040 (L) Delegation of department director authority
  - Request to have the delegation limited to 30 days, unless approved by CM
    - Code already requires CM approval, so not necessary to make change
