

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-080

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONA, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING AN APPLICATION FEE FOR AN OUTDOOR SIDEWALK DINING PERMIT AND OUTDOOR RETAIL KIOSK PERMIT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Downtown Corona Revitalization Specific Plan (“Specific Plan”) Section 3.8.1.C(1), a ministerial permit is required for a business engaging in outdoor sidewalk dining; and

WHEREAS, Specific Plan Section 3.8.1.C(2) provides that the application fee for outdoor sidewalk dining permits shall be established by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Specific Plan Section 3.8.6.D(1), a ministerial permit is required for any person engaging in outdoor retail kiosk activities; and

WHEREAS, Specific Plan Section 3.8.6.D(1) provides that the application fee for outdoor retail kiosk permits shall be established by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish the fees for applications for outdoor sidewalk dining permits and outdoor retail kiosk permits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONA, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals set forth above are hereby adopted as findings in support of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Outdoor Sidewalk Dining Permit Fee. There is hereby established and adopted a fee of Three Hundred Seven Dollars (\$307) for application of an outdoor sidewalk dining permit required by Section 3.8.1.C(1) of the Downtown Corona Revitalization Specific Plan. The City Council finds and determines that this fee does not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of processing and issuing an outdoor sidewalk dining permit. This fee shall be included in the City’s annual fee study and may be amended by resolution of the City Council.

SECTION 3. Outdoor Retail Kiosk Permit Fee. There is hereby established and adopted a fee of One Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$167) for application of an outdoor retail kiosk permit required by Section 3.8.6.D(1) of the Downtown Corona Revitalization Specific Plan. The City Council finds and determines that this fee does not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of processing and issuing an outdoor retail kiosk permit. This fee shall be included in the City’s annual fee study and may be amended by resolution of the City Council.

EXHIBIT 1

SECTION 4 CEQA Findings. This Resolution is exempt pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), which states that a project is exempt from CEQA if the activity is covered by the common sense rule that CEQA applies only to projects that have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA. This Resolution simply adopts a fee for permit applications and there is no possibility that adopting this Resolution will have a significant effect on the environment. Therefore, no environmental analysis is required.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. The Mayor shall sign this Resolution and the City Clerk shall attest thereto, and this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force on the date of its adoption.
