The cities new Skyline Master plan contains plans for a Bathroom. This bathroom is of concern to me because of it's location and the possible problems that would cause to our neighborhood in Orchard Glen

I have a few suggestions and concerns about the placement of this restroom

- Bathrooms often attract the homeless population
- Bathrooms are often vandalized and have Graffiti
- A bathroom on our street reduces our ability to allow our children to safely play outside in their own neighborhood
- A bathroom on our street will negatively impact our property value

Options:

- No bathroom at all but signage reminding hikers to pack in and pack out all waste
- A bathroom and parking lot along the outside of the flood basin on Chase (Oce proposed by Nelson Nelson. This could be locked during afterhours and has excellent access to Skyline. This would also allow you to put more handicapped parking spaces near the trail on Foothill Blvd.
- Installing the bathroom at the intersection of Foothill and the Trail head. Utilities are already there and this location is less likely to be vandalized due to the number of onlookers. Another benefit is that it does not directly negatively impact the community of Orchard Glen
- Making a new Trailhead a little further up on Foothill near Chase that connects to the current trail and installing a bathroom an parking lot at that location
