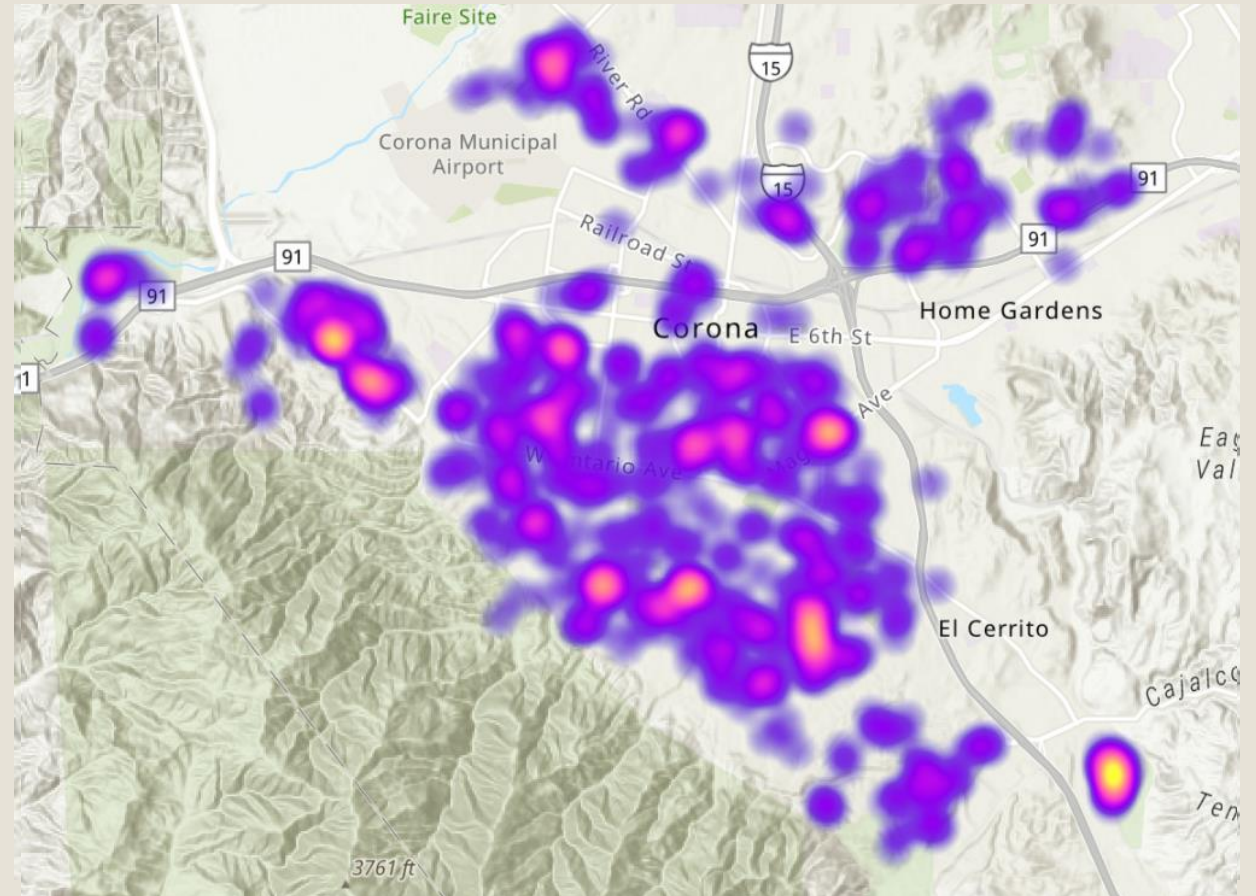

Consistently positive sentiment in key areas

Significant changes

- Efforts to Reduce Homelessness (+4%)
- Sense of Community (+5%)
- Variety & Frequency of Community Events (+9%)

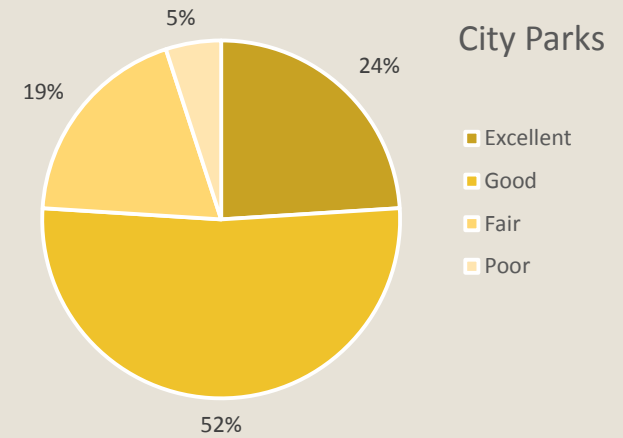
Random Sample Survey

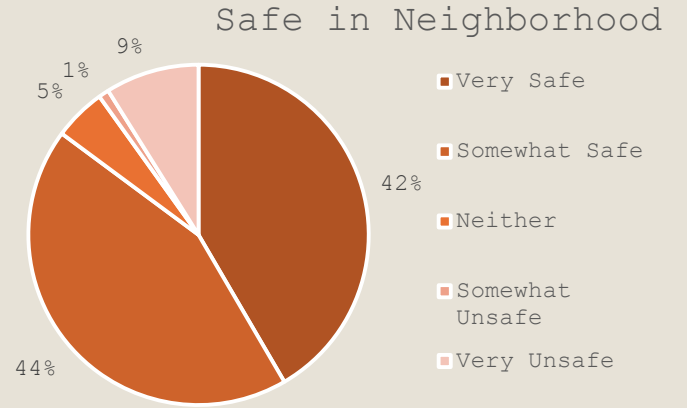

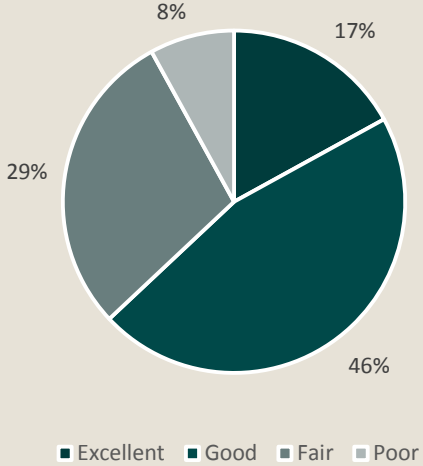

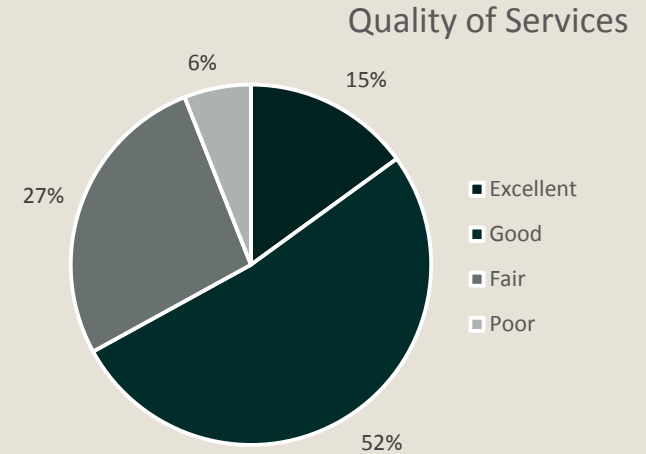

Conclusions

- Robust process to hear from a representative sample of residents about key issues over time.
 - Open survey results (n= 901) were on average ~11% more negative than the results more negative than the results from the random sample (n= 652).
