

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING SCHEDULE FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026

WHEREAS, The Ralph M. Brown Act (“The Brown Act”), specifically Government Code Section 54954 (Rules for Conduct of Business: Time and Place For Holding Regular Meetings), provides that the City Council shall provide the time and place for holding its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, The Brown Act allows the City Council to take such action by ordinance, resolution, bylaw, or other authorized action; and

WHEREAS, Corona Municipal Code (“CMC”) Section 2.08.010 (Meetings - Regular - Time, Place) of Chapter 2.08 (City Council) now provides that the regular meeting start times shall be designated each calendar year by a resolution duly adopted by the City Council before the start of the calendar year; and

WHEREAS, CMC Section 2.08.010 also provides that if the City Council wishes to change the start time for any particular regular meeting to an earlier time, it shall do so by a resolution duly adopted at least fourteen (14) calendar days in advance of such meeting; and

WHEREAS, by this Resolution the City Council would like to establish its regular meeting start times for the remainder of calendar year 2026; and

WHEREAS, by this Resolution the City Council would also like to announce the proposed dates of any special meetings that - at this time - it is aware that it may hold. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the dates and/or times of any special meeting(s) announced by this Resolution are subject to change, since the City Council retains its authority to call any special meeting in compliance with The Brown Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONA, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby adopts the 2026 City Council Meeting Schedule (Regular & Special Meetings) attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
