History & Background

History

- Established in 1913
- Community gathering place for parades, picnics, and celebrations
- Home of the historic "Municipal Plunge"
- Founders Monument constructed in 1936

Decline of City Park

- Attendance decline began in 1980's
- Safety concerns and deteriorating conditions
- City Park pool closed in 2020



Vision & Planning

Strategic Plan Objective

Redevelop City park, including a new full-service, purpose-built community center.

City Park Master Plan

- Started June 2022
- 18-month process
- Community-based plan
- Outreach and engagement
- 2,100 survey responses
- Adopted by City Council on July 19, 2023

Design Milestones

- 30% CD completed January 2025
- 60% CD completed April 2025
- 90% CD completed December 2025



Vibrant

Gathering place for people, picnics, events, community celebrations.

Multigenerational

Safe, family-friendly inclusive park for people of all abilities.

Honors our past and looks boldly to the future.

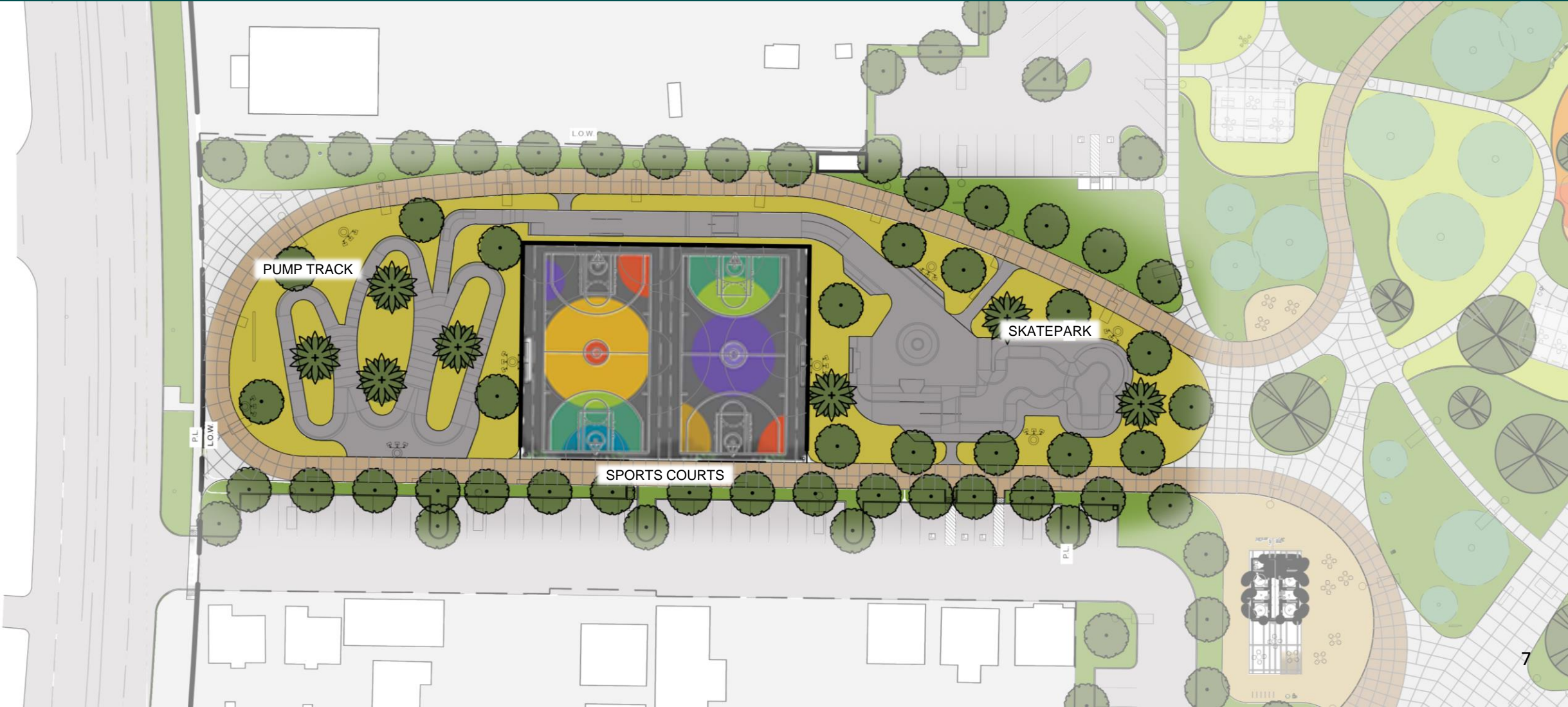

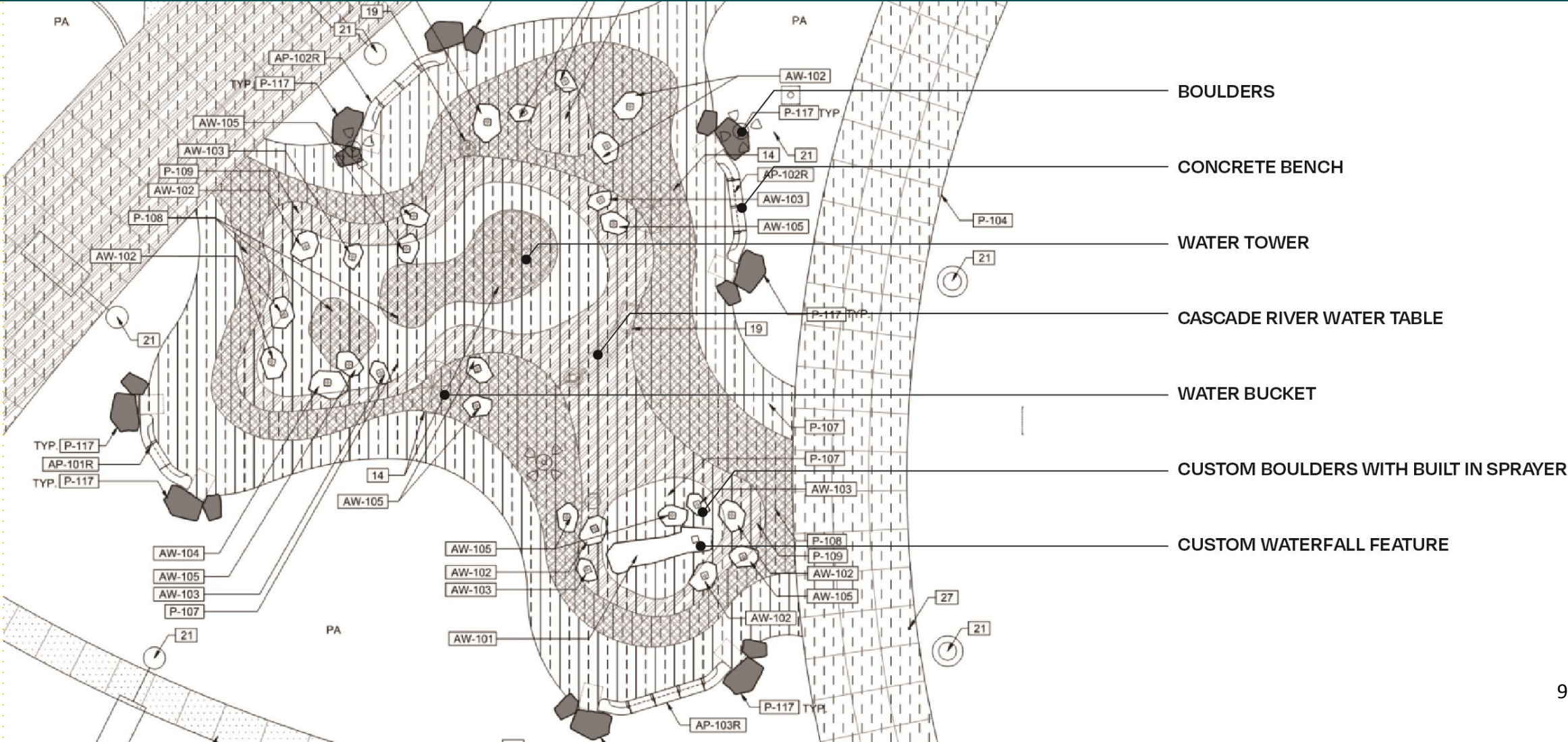

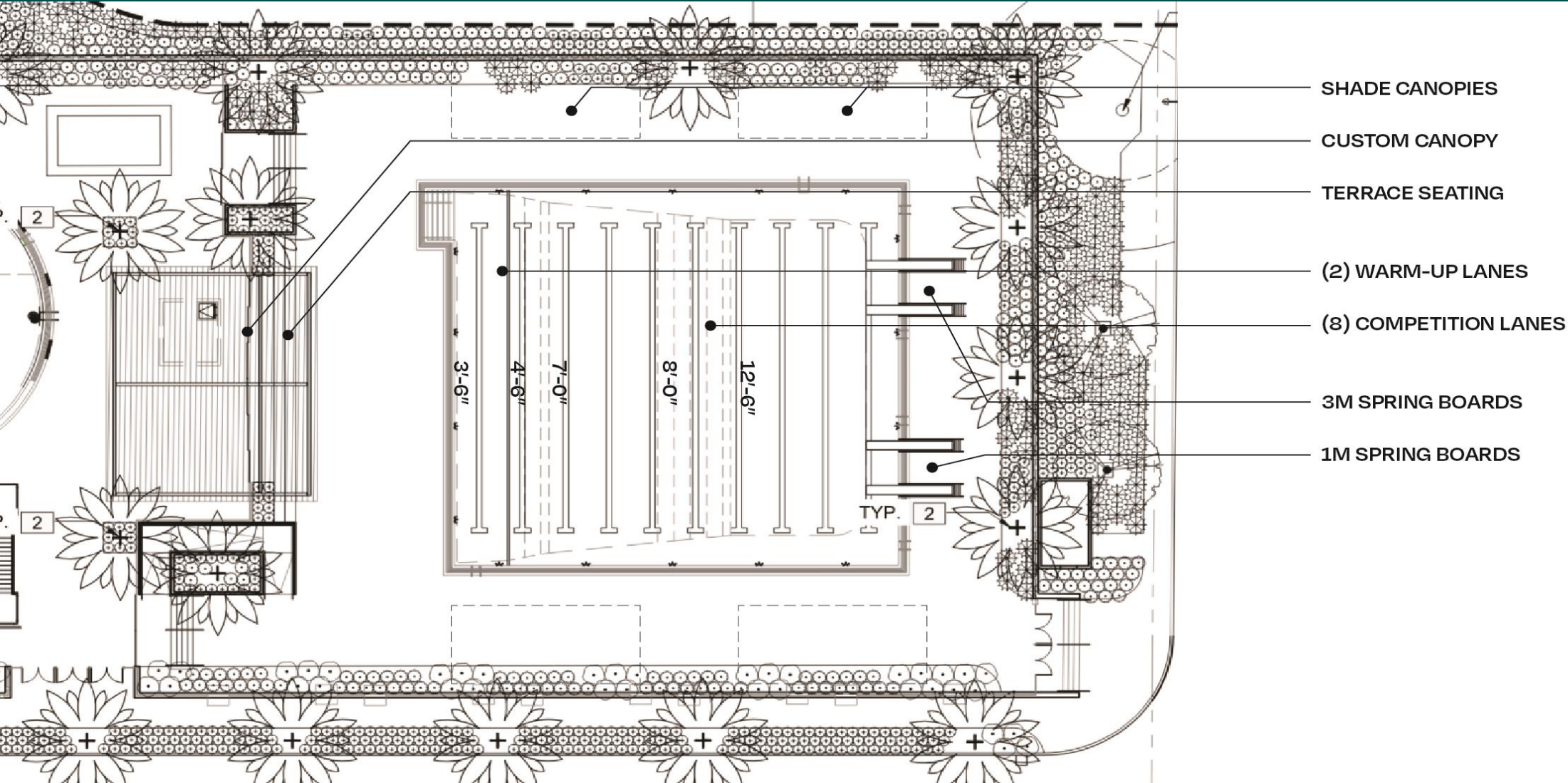

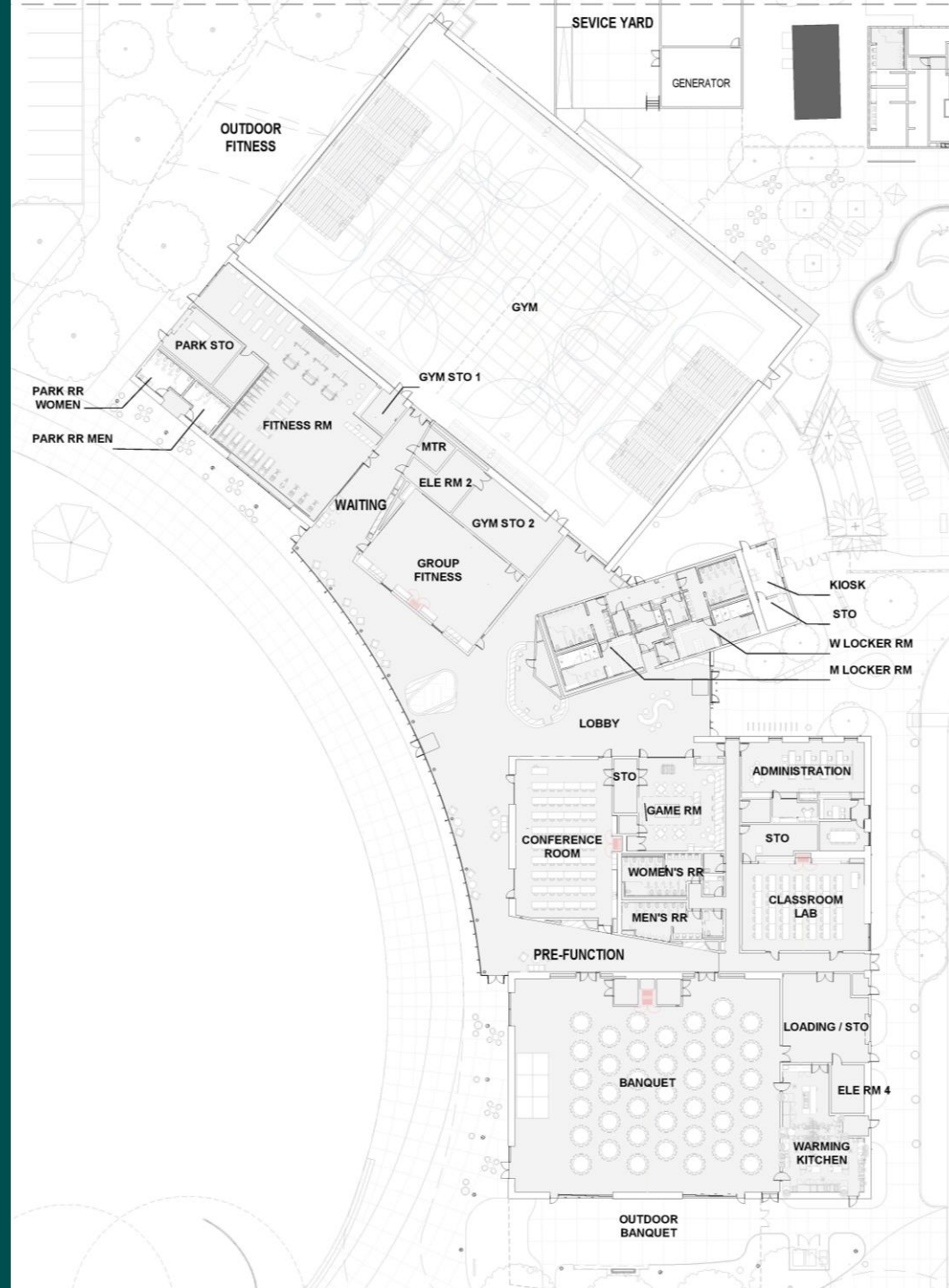

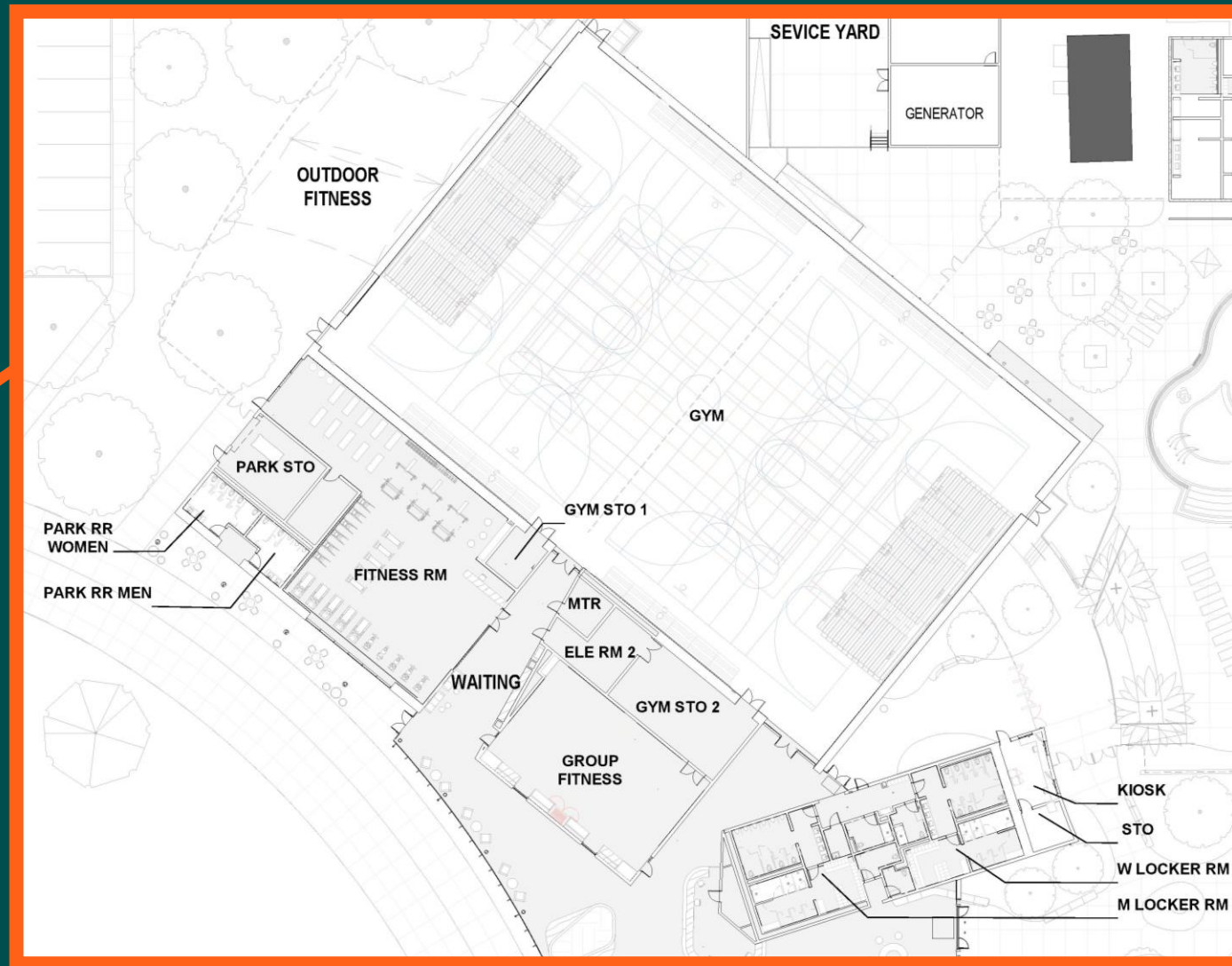

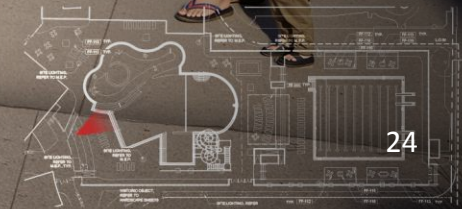

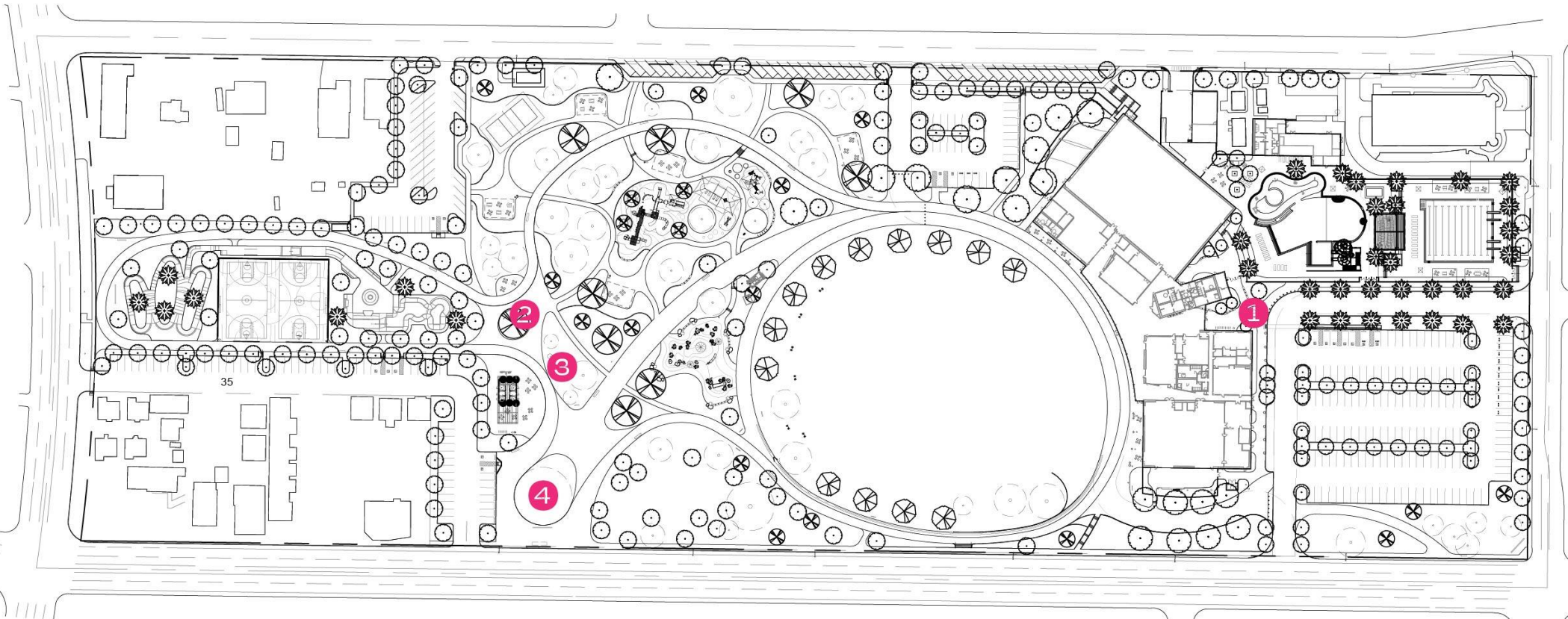
Tree Relocation and Preservation
